

# BOAT TRIPS

from the Melbourne Arm of the Pocklington Canal

Join members of the canal society for a trip aboard **New Horizons** and discover more about the attractive Pocklington Canal. The canal is now over 200 years old, with four historic road bridges and nine locks. It is one of the best canals in Britain for diversity of wildlife.



**Short trips** (about 30 mins) run on most Sundays and Bank Holidays from the start of April to the end of

October. **No booking is required.** We start at noon and the last trip is around 4.15 pm. Children must be accompanied by an adult and may take turns to steer the boat under supervision. We welcome donations, which help cover running costs of the boat and help us restore and maintain the canal.

**Longer trips** (daytime and evening) on the canal are available for groups of up to 12 passengers, but these must be booked. Please book well in advance. You are welcome to bring food and drink and we will provide tea and coffee. Everyone may be given the chance to steer the boat.
