Short trips (about mins) run on most Sundays and Bank Holidays from Easter to the end of



October. *No booking is required.* We start at noon and the last trip is around 4.15 pm. Children must be accompanied by an adult and can take turns to steer the boat under supervision. We welcome donations, which help cover running costs of the boat and help us restore and maintain the canal.

Longer trips (daytime and evening) on the canal are available for groups of up to 12 passengers, but these must be booked. Please book well in advance. You are welcome to bring food and drink and we will provide tea and coffee. Everyone can have a go at steering the boat.
